THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE KENDAL AND BOWNESS AREAS
OF SOUTH LAKELAND)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2013

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Cumbria County Council to facilitate a VIP visit, the County Council of Cumbria has made an Order the effect of which is to: -

1. Prohibit any vehicle, other than those VIP convoy vehicles being used in connection with the event/visit, from proceeding along the lengths of road specified and at the time specified in the attached Schedule.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times

2. Prohibit any vehicle from waiting, on the days and during the times specified, on the following lengths of road:-

- (i) **Highgate, Kendal** – Both sides of the road from its junction with Allhallows Lane/Lowther Street to its junction with Stricklandgate.

Duration: From 1800 hours on 16 July 2013 until 1400 hours on 17 July 2013.

- (ii) **Stricklandgate, Kendal** – Both sides of the road from its junction with Highgate to its junction with Library Road.

Duration: From 1800 hours on 16 July 2013 until 1400 hours on 17 July 2013

- (iii) **Market Place, Kendal** – Both sides of the road from its junction with Stricklandgate to its junction with Branthwaite Brow.

Duration: From 1800 hours on 16 July 2013 until 1400 hours on 17 July 2013.

- (iv) **Glebe Road, Bowness** – Both sides of the road from its junction with the A592 Lake Road, extending around the loop to a point 30 metres west of its junction with the Braithwaite Fold car park entrance, a distance of approximately 800 metres.

Duration: From 1800 hours on 16 July 2013 until 1800 hours on 17 July 2013.

To facilitate the route of the VIP convoy vehicles the following existing restrictions will be temporarily suspended for the duration of the event:-

- (a) One-Way restriction on Glebe Road, Bowness from its junction with Bowness Promenade, extending towards its junction with the A592 road at Birkett Hill.

Duration: From 0800 hours to 1400 hours on 17 July 2013.

- (b) Prohibition of Driving along that section of Stricklandgate, Kendal from its junction with Library Road to its junction with Highgate and that section of Highgate, Kendal from its junction with Stricklandgate to its junction with Allhallows Lane/Lowther Street.

Duration: From midnight on 16 July 2013 to 1400 hours on 17 July 2013.

- (c) One-Way restriction along that section of Stricklandgate, Kendal from its junction with Library Road to its junction with Highgate, in that direction and that section of Highgate, Kendal from its junction with Stricklandgate to its junction with Allhallows Lane/Lowther Street, in the direction.

Duration: From midnight on 16 July 2013 to 1400 hours on 17 July 2013.

The above restriction shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purpose of an undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into the section of road to which the order applies.

The above restriction shall not apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a constable in uniform.

The Order will come into operation on 16 July 2013 and may continue in force for a period of up to three days from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed, although it is anticipated that it will only be required **on Tuesday 16 July 2013 and Wednesday 17 July 2013.**

SCHEDULE

EXTENT OF RESTRICTIONS, ALTERNATIVE ROUTES AND DURATION

1. **A6 Highgate and Stricklandgate, Kendal – Duration: From midnight on 16 July 2013 to 1400 hours on 17 July 2013**
From its junction with Allhallows Lane and Lowther Street through to Stricklandgate and its junction with Library Road.
There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles.
2. **Market Place and Branthwaite Brow, Kendal – Duration: From midnight on 16 July 2013 to 1700 hours on 17 July 2013**
From its junction with Stricklandgate continuing for its entire length through Branthwaite Brow to its junction with Upper Stramongate.
There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles.
3. **Finkle Street, Kendal – Duration: From midnight on 16 July 2013 to 1700 hours on 17 July 2013**
From its junction with Highgate, extending for its entire length to its junction with Upper Stramongate.
There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles.
4. **Kent Street, Kendal – Duration: From 0800 hours to 1700 hours on 17 July 2013**
From its junction with Branthwaite Brow and Finkle Street to its junction with Back Finkle Street, a distance of approximately 50 metres.
There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles.
5. **Upper Stramongate, Kendal – Duration: From 0800 hours to 1700 hours on 17 July 2013**
From its junction with Branthwaite Brow and Finkle Street, extending for its entire length to its junction with Blackhall Road.
There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles.

- 6. Stricklandgate, Kendal – Duration:** From 0900 hours to 1200 hours on 17 July 2013, although it is anticipated the road will only be closed for approximately 20 mins as and when the traffic signs are in place
From its junction with Library Road to its junction with Sandes Avenue.
There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles.
- 7. Glebe Road, Bowness – Duration:** From 0800 hours to 1400 hours on 17 July 2013
From its junction with the A592 Lake Road, extending for a distance of approximately 800 metres around the loop to a point approximately 30 metres west of the entrance to Braithwaite Fold car park.
A suitable alternative route for south bound vehicles will be available via the A592 and Glebe Road.
- 8. A592 Lake Road and Promenade, Bowness – Duration:** From 1000 hours to 1400 hours on 17 July 2013 although it is anticipated the road will only be closed for approximately 20 mins as and when the traffic signs are in place
From its junction with Belsfield Road, extending in a northerly direction continuing adjacent to the Promenade to its westerly junction with Church Street, a distance of approximately 400 metres.
A suitable alternative route will be available via Belsfield Road, the A5084 Kendal Road and the A592.
