FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – FOI 856/24 Hate crimes with u18 offenders

I refer to your request for information received by Cumbria Constabulary on the 23rd of September 2024. I note you seek access to the following information:

How many hate crime or hate incidents involving child perpetrators have been reported to the force in 2024 so far (as of 22/9/2024)

Your request for information has now been considered and I can confirm Cumbria Constabulary does hold some information relevant to your request and where this is the case I have today decided to disclose this to you.

The information provided in response to your request has been extracted from the Constabulary's crime recording system, a filter has been used to identify crimes with a hate crime flag. Please note that there can be multiple offenders and suspects per crime and the data provided is the distinct number of crimes not the number of suspects/ offenders under 18. It should also be noted that all reported incidents of hate crime with child perpetrators had a related hate crime, and it is the hate crime figure which has been provided.

Number of recorded crimes with the hate crime flag involving a suspect or offender under 18 between 01/01/2024 - 22/09/2024

Answer – 136 crimes
