FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – FOI 1171/25 Speeding Fines

I refer to your request for information which was received by Cumbria Constabulary on 5th August 2025. I note you seek access to the following information:

- 1. The total number (and monetary amount) of fines issued for speeding, over a 12 month period [between June 2024 - June 2025].*
 - Broken down by age of driver if possible.*

Your request for information has now been considered and I can confirm Cumbria Constabulary does hold some information relevant to your request and where this is the case I have today decided to disclose this to you.

Please note: Not all ages are available currently, these have been included in the table below.

There were 40,436 fines issues between 1st June 2024 and 30th June 2025. Each fine was for £100 and 3 penalty points.
