FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – FOI 755/25 Anti-Social Behaviour

I refer to your request for information which was received by Cumbria Constabulary on 22nd July 2025. I note you seek access to the following information:

- 1. How many incidents of anti-social behaviour were reported to your force in the past four full calendar years: 2024, 2023, 2022, 2021?*
- 2. How many of those reports led to a police officer attending the scene of the incident (broken down by calendar year for the same number of years)?*

Your request for information has now been considered and I can confirm Cumbria Constabulary does hold some information relevant to your request and where this is the case I have today decided to disclose this to you.

Please note: the information provided was extracted from Cumbria Constabulary's crime recording system. Grouping type of 'ASB' for incidents was used for this request, this includes all types of ASB; "environmental", "nuisance" & "personal".

Question 1.

The number of incidents of anti-social behaviour that were reported to Cumbria Constabulary in the past four full calendar years.
