Your request for information has now been considered, and I can confirm Cumbria Constabulary does hold some information relevant to your request and where this is the case I have today decided to disclose this to you.

Please note: Victim Occupation is not a mandatory recording field in the Crime System. The recording of Crimes Against Police Officers (while on duty) is now recorded with greater accuracy and consistency which it may not have been in 2022/23.

Police forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally.
