FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – FOI 1206/25 Sexual Offences Handling

I refer to your request for information which was received by Cumbria Constabulary on 8th August 2025. I note you seek access to the following information:

- *Please provide the information requested below for the five-year period up to and including today: from 9 August 2020 to 8 August 2025 inclusive. Where you hold data by calendar or financial year, please provide a yearly breakdown for: 2020 (partial: from 9 Aug 2020), 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025 (partial: to 8 Aug 2025).*
- *For every item below, break down results by year and by victim age group: Child (under 18 at date of report) and Adult (18 and over at date of report). Please also include a total for the whole period.*
- *If a dataset field cannot be produced exactly as requested, please provide the nearest equivalent exportable data (e.g., internal category codes) and explain the difference.*

Section A — Child victims warned they could be subject to criminal investigation/arrest

1. *For incidents involving a child victim, the number of occasions where police informed the child or child family that they themselves could be subject to criminal investigation or arrest under the Sexual Offences Act where the other party was an adult. - Privacy note: only aggregate counts are requested. Where any town-level count would be fewer than 5 individuals, please merge into an “<5 / suppressed” category to protect privacy.



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Definitions & notes for clarity

Sexual Offences Act: use your force's local crime-recording tags / NCRS/IMPACT categories that constitute sexual offences. If you use different classification, please provide a mapping.

Victim age: classify by victim age at date of report (child = under 18; adult = 18+).

Arrest / charged / convicted: use force operational records. If conviction data is held by courts and not in force systems, please indicate that and provide what you can.

"Informed" the child: include any instance where police explicitly told a child or the guardian of the child they the child could be investigated/charged, whether verbally or in writing.

Town boundaries: if you publish standard tables by town/sector/beat, please use those published categories and indicate the category name used.

Your request for information has now been considered and I can advise you the Constabulary does hold information relevant to your request; however, the information is not held in a format which enables the requested information to be retrieved automatically.

To answer most of the questions that have been asked it would require a manual review of the available information in multiple sections as they are not in a recordable field and would be recorded in notes, files or within records. Specifically, Section A would require manual review of all crimes with a child victim, Section B would require a manual review of each case with public statement, Section C would require a manual review of all arrests and complaints as they may not be linked, Section E (6) would require a manual review of all crimes, Section E (8) would require a manual review of all complaints and Section F (Questions 9b, 9c, and 9d and 10) would require a manual review off all sex offender cases. I have estimated the time required to extract the relevant information required will exceed the "appropriate limit" as this would require a manual review of all relevant entries listed above.

The "appropriate limit" is set out in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004 and the current limit for police forces is set at £450, which equates to 18 hours of work.

Section 12(1) of the Freedom of Information Act does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information, if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request will exceed the appropriate limit. In view of this, and in accordance with Section 17(5) of the Act, this letter serves as a Refusal Notice for your request.

Notwithstanding the above, in anticipation it will still be of interest to you, it is possible to provide you with some of the information requested in the remaining questions, as it was possible to retrieve this information directly. This is information I would otherwise have advised you to submit a revised request to seek disclosure of in accordance with the duty to provide advice and assistance.

Section D — Outcomes for sexual offences reports

Question 5

Please note: Due to the request requiring victim details, the data is crime data where there is a victim recorded on the crime. The data is a distinct count of crime number. Victim ages under 1 and over 99 are classed as 'Unknown'.

Cumbria Constabulary do not have access to prosecution data and there is no outcome for released pending further investigation. NFA outcomes are provided as A), OC1 and 1a for C). Please note that the other positive outcomes and crimes under investigation are excluded from this data as they were not asked for - this is only data with either an NFA outcome or a charge outcome. Cases with N100 outcomes were also excluded.
