**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – FOI 1627/25 Data for fixed speed camera at Smithfield village on A6071 between Brampton and Longtown**

I refer to your request for information which was received by Cumbria Constabulary on 21<sup>st</sup> December 2025. I note you seek access to the following information:

*I would like to submit for FOI to obtain Data for fixed speed camera quite recently installed at Smithfield village on A6071 between Brampton and Longtown*

*Details for the whole time this speed camera has been operating please - all data available.*

Your request for information has now been considered, and I can confirm Cumbria Constabulary does hold some information relevant to your request and where this is the case I have today decided to disclose this to you.

There have been 2321 notices issued from the camera detailed above from go live on 24 November 25 to 31 December 25 which is where processing is up to at present.

Police forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies, and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons this force's response to your questions should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you may receive.

Whilst every care has been taken in the retrieval of the information provided, please do not hesitate to contact us for clarification, if you do have any issues or queries relating to this data.

**Complaint Rights**

If you believe your request has not been properly handled, or you are otherwise dissatisfied with the outcome of your request, you have the right to request an internal review.

In the first instance, please email [freedomofinformation@cumbria.police.uk](mailto:freedomofinformation@cumbria.police.uk) quoting the FOI reference number and explain why you are dissatisfied. Your complaint will be considered, and a response will be provided to you after your complaint has been investigated.

If you remain dissatisfied following conclusion of the internal review, you have the right, under section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to complain directly to the Information Commissioner.
